Greater configurability

Configurable to single or multi-currency, the sidecar offers all your customers a new range of secure and convenient transactions. Smaller footprint module which minimizes wasted space for rarely used coin denominations. Maximize uptime and availability by reducing the need for replenishments.

With more smaller coin magazines, this means greater configurability – maximizing the most optimal coin denominations. By adding coin dispense to your self-service channel, you can migrate time-consuming transactions away from the teller line, leaving your staff to focus on other high value activities.

Flexible and modular

The coin dispense sidecar has flexible placement options, giving you the freedom to locate it where it makes the most sense.

The modular nature means that if the initial placement option doesn't meet your business case, the slimline sidecar can be easily relocated to a more optimal location where there is a SelfServ ATM. Options also exist for future capabilities to be added to the self-service channel.
